Students from the School of Architecture and Design (as appropriate according to the academic areas agreed in the Inter-institutional agreement), Undergraduate level.

The application should contain:

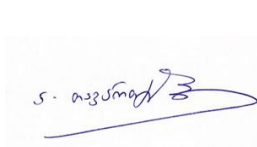
1. Academic record.
2. Personal CV in English.
3. English certificate: B2 or higher (IELTS or TOEFL)
4. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why she/he wishes to participate in this exchange.
5. Recommendation Letter from Faculty

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

1. The GPA (5 points);
2. English Certificate (B2- 5 points);
3. The motivation letter (3 points);
4. Recommendation Letter from faculty (5 points)
5. EUROPASS CV (2 points)
