The application should contain:

1. Academic record.

3. English certificate: B2 or higher
4. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why she/he wishes to participate in this exchange.
5. Others/Spanish language (optional).

Doctoral students must previously agree on the stay with the UPV professor who will supervise their research during the mobility. They shall present a document that refers to the research to be carried out at the UPV, with the approval of both the thesis supervisor and the UPV professor.



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SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

1. The GPA (5 points);
2. English Certificate (B2 4 points, C1 4,5 points and C2 5 points);
3. The motivation letter (5 points);
4. Applicant's CV (5 points)
5. The level of Spanish Language through the presentation of the certificate or equivalent accreditation (5 points).
