Students from de Faculty of Information Technologies (as appropriate according to the academic areas agreed in the Inter-institutional agreement): Undergraduate

APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED: BEFORE April 01, 2026 to (International Relations Office

The application should contain:

1. Academic record.
2. Personal CV in English.
3. English certificate: B2 or higher
4. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why she/he wishes to participate in this exchange.
5. Proposal of the Learning agreement signed by the coordinator

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

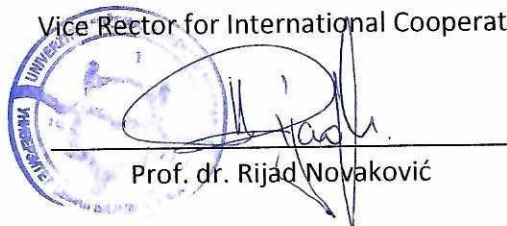


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Criteria	score
1. Academic merits (Grade Point Average) of the nominee	Minimally 1 Maximally 10
2. Matching of study programs based on the proposed learning agreement (within the same cycle)	Minimally 1 Maximally 10
3. Motivation to go on mobility	Minimally 1 Maximally 10
4. Knowledge of English or the official language of the institution to which the student wishes to be nominated	B1 =2; B2=3; C1=4; C2=5;
5. Recommendation of the coordinator of the Faculty where the nominated student is enrolled at	YES/NO YES=+5 NO=-5
6. Learning agreement signed by faculty coordinator/head of department/dean	YES/NO YES=+5 NO=-5
7. The student knows the language of the host institution	+ 5 points

The list of candidates with the scores obtained will be sent by mail to all nominees with the scores and information who is nominated for mobility.
