Within the framework of the Erasmus+ Program KA171 2025-2028, Lviv Polytechnic National University – LVIV, nominates the below-listed exchange staff to participate in a short stay for the Blend Intensive Program “ENCHANCING Sustainable communication, professional competences, AI” at the Universitat Politècnica de València, in March 2026.

Due to the exceptional circumstances in Ukraine resulting from the war with Russia, where access to centres is impossible, and electricity and internet access are limited to a few hours per week, the official internal nomination procedure of LVIV cannot be carried out as usual.
